It is important to note that the parent or guardian must provide supervision for their son or daughter until they get on the bus in the morning. This means that you need to wait with your student at the specified pick-up location. In some cases, it might be a designated parent or guardian who will provide supervision for a group of students. The parent or guardian assumes all responsibility and risk for their students' safety and supervision before the morning pick-up. This also holds true for the afternoon drop-off. Once the student has been safely delivered to the afternoon drop-off location, the parent or guardian assumes all responsibility for the student's safety and supervision. Your signature on this document means that you understand your responsibilities for your student's supervision and safety and assume all risk and responsibility.

Below you will find the transportation schedule for your son or daughter for the 2023-2024 school year. Returning riders: please note that our arrival and departure schedules have changed!

There will be a return trip in the afternoon. Classes end at 2:55 PM each day. FLEX is available on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday; this time is provided for students to meet with their teachers, receive tutoring, attend club meetings, etc.

Parents/Guardians are responsible to transport their sons or daughters from TCHS if they need to stay on campus beyond the day's scheduled departure time. As the need to adjust the transportation schedule arises, we will inform you of all pertinent information.

If you commit to using bus transportation, even if it is only one trip per month, there is a fixed fee per month. The first payment is due by September 1, 2023, and all subsequent payments will be due by the first of each month. Payment may be given to the bus driver. Checks are payable to Trinity Catholic High School. Please write TRANSPORTATION FOR (MONTH) on each check.
